ENTRY FEE

All entrants are required to be members of the English Chess Federation (ECF) at Silver level or above. Bronze or non-members will pay a surcharge of £7.50 on top of the basic entry fee of £16.00 (£13.00 juniors).

NOTE: ECF MEMBERSHIP YEAR FINISHES ON 31 AUGUST

To avoid paying the additional £7.50 you must buy or renew your Silver membership or above before playing in this event.

Non-ENG PLAYERS who belong to a FIDE nation other than ENG (e.g. SCO or USA) don't need to belong to the ECF but it will cost them more to play. HOWEVER you do need to quote a FIN (FIDE Identification Number) with your entry. Non-English players will have to obtain a FIN from their national federation in good time prior to the tournament otherwise you cannot enter.

LATE ENTRIES

Space at the playing venue is limited. Please enter early to avoid disappointment and to aid administration. Entries submitted after 25 August 2018 will only be accepted at the Organiser's discretion and will be subject to a £5.00 surcharge.

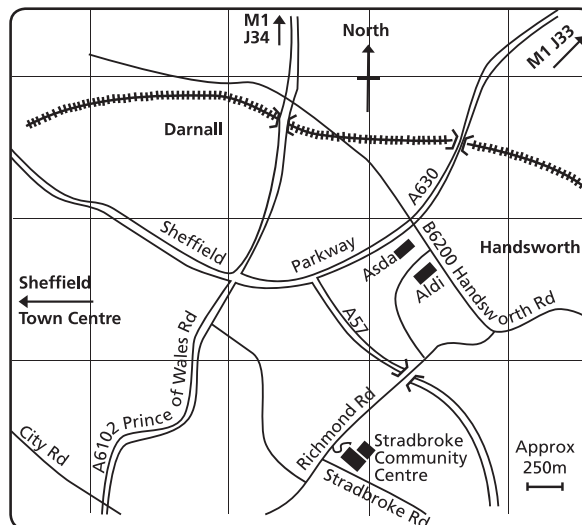
GRADING AND RATING

Eligibility for the sections will be based on the latest available ECF grading list. The following priority will be used for section allocation:

1. ECF Rapidplay Grade
2. ECF Standard play Grade
3. FIDE Rapidplay Rating — converted to ECF grade
4. Other Grade or Rating — converted if necessary

ACCESSIBILITY

The playing area at the venue is wheelchair accessible and the venue has a disabled toilet. Disabled competitors should contact the Organiser (details above) about any special requirements they may have. Such requirements will be catered for wherever possible.



HOW TO FIND US

By Car

Leave the M1 at junction 33 and head towards Sheffield along the A630. Take the second turn-off and turn left at the roundabout onto the B6200 to Handsworth. Asda supermarket will be on your right. Turn right at the lights after Asda, but before Aldi, onto Richmond Park Road. Travel to the end and turn right again, this time onto Richmond Road. After 500 metres the road rises slightly. The left turn into Stradbroke Primary School and Community Centre is immediately prior to a pelican crossing halfway up the rise.

From Sheffield centre, head for M1 motorway along the A57 / A630 Sheffield Parkway. Turn right towards Handsworth on the B6200 and follow the above directions from there.

By Bus

The number 74 bus stops outside the Community Centre. Services depart from Sheffield Interchange. The services are half hourly and the bus that leaves the Interchange at 09.35* should arrive at the playing venue around 09.50*.

Services 24 (*First*) and 25 (*Stagecoach*) leave Arundel Gate in Sheffield approximately every ten minutes. Both services stop about 200 metres from the playing venue. Aim for the 09.07*, 09.19* or 09.29* departures.

RATE OF PLAY

Each player will have 25 minutes per game plus an increment of 5 seconds per move throughout. There is no requirement to record the moves.

LATE ARRIVAL FOR ANY ROUND

Players will be defaulted if they have not arrived at their board within 10 minutes of the start of the round. Re-pairing will take place if possible.

HALF POINT BYE IN ROUND 1

Players may request a half point bye in Round 1 only if they do so at the time of submitting their entry.

A bye will not be allowed in the final round. Byes in other rounds will be at the Organiser's discretion and must be requested in advance.

PAIRINGS

Pairings will be made according to FIDE Pairing Rules using the Swiss Manager program.

FIDE LAWS OF CHESS

All sections will be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess and in particular Appendix Article A.4 relating to Rapidplay events. You are strongly advised to make yourself familiar with these laws. See: www.fide.com/fide/handbook.html

PHOTOGRAPHS

Darnall & Handsworth Chess Club would like to take photographs on the day for publicity purposes, e.g. for use on its website; or in a press release. If you object to this then please inform the Organiser, Geoff Brown, in writing before the tournament.

CAR PARKING

Car parking for about 50 vehicles is available at the playing venue. Otherwise please use surrounding streets.

REFRESHMENTS

Tea and coffee will be available at the playing venue. Shops, café and fast food outlets are about 500 metres away.

MOBILE PHONES / ELECTRONIC DEVICES

During a game, a player is forbidden to have a mobile phone, electronic means of communication or any device capable of suggesting chess moves on their person in the playing venue. Such devices may be stored in a bag as long as the device is completely switched off.

If you are found with a device in your possession when away from the board, e.g. in the toilets, then you will lose your game and may be banned from the rest of the tournament and / or future events.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Organiser reserves the right to refuse an entry, or transfer an entry to another section, without explanation.

Ungraded players cannot win a grading prize and, with the exception of the Open, may only win 50% of any other prize.

Competitors can only win one prize and prizes will be allocated as the Organiser sees fit.

The advertised prizes may be changed subject to the number of entries received.

In the event of a dispute, the decisions of the Organiser and/or Chief Arbiter will be final in all matters. Players must agree to their grading information being published on the ECF website.

The submission of an entry form and payment of the entry fee denotes acceptance of the tournament's terms and conditions.
